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This is an optional course for On-Campus Quran Hifz + Basic Schooling in Ranchi

The idea of this program is to ensure students become hafiz when they reach standard eight in our Hifz and Schooling twinning program. Thereafter all students will be given a Medical/IIT foundation course for 2 years while completing standards 9 and 10, along with completing the CBSE board examination. Students who are hafiz gain exceptional analytical skills and develop intensive memory power, which will pave the smooth transition to attaining effective and intensive training in standards 11 and 12 for Medical/IIT competitive examinations at Maria International School.

Hifz + CBSE Schooling Twinning Program : Students are accepted on-campus till Grade 6, as it is expected to complete memorizing holy Quran by the end of Grade 8.

Maria International School has introduced the Hafiz Scholar Program. This program is open to day scholars (daily commuters) as well as for distant participants as residential scholars. This program features intensive 8 hours of training for memorizing the Holy Quran. Along with Hifz, the students will be trained in English, Mathematics, Science, and SST for additional 2.5 hours daily to complete academic CBSE schooling. In-sha-Allah, students will become hafiz in 2 to 3 years and yet complete basic schooling in core subjects with English as a medium of language. Separate hostel accommodation for outstation students are available for both boys and girls. A hijab is mandatory for girls. 5 times Namaz is mandatory for all residential students
